



AERIAL APPLICATION CONSENT  
PERMISSION TO SPRAY INSIDE 150MTRS HORIZONTALLY/300 FEET VERTICALLY  
OF YOUR BOUNDARY

Dear Client,

It is necessary for us to obtain written permission from the principal occupiers that are within 150 metres horizontally/300 feet vertically, of the area required to be treated in accordance with the Pesticides and Allied Chemicals Act 1978 which has been reproduced for your information.

**Pesticides and Allied Chemicals Act 1978\***  
**Order Under Section 49A (1)**  
**Order Number Air 1**

I, Harvey John Baker, being the Registrar of pesticides appointed under the Pesticides and Allied Chemicals Act 1978, and in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Act, and with consent of the Minister for Agriculture, do this by my order, require that any person applying a pesticide from an aircraft shall release discharge or apply such pesticide within distance of 150 metres horizontally/300 feet vertically from the boundary of any dwelling, school premises, factory premises, or any public place **without the owner of the property on which the pesticide is applied or his/her nominee having obtained prior consent in writing from the occupier of the dwelling, school, factory or public place, as the case may be, unless otherwise authorised in writing by Registrar of Pesticides.**

**Further Terms and Conditions**

1. In this order – Dwelling means any premises usually used for human habitation as a home including any yard, garden, garage or outhouse. Public place includes any public park or garden, playing field, or any place to which the public have or are permitted to have access, but the purpose of this order excludes roads, travelling stock reserves and State Rail Land.
2. This order does not constitute any recommendation by the Registrar of Pesticides, the Government, a department of Government, a Governmental authority, an organisation, a corporation, or any other person.
3. No guarantee is given and no responsibility, risk or liability is accepted, as to the effectiveness, safety including safety of the public, any individual, crops or other vegetation, or the environment, or any other thing, which may, or may not, occur as a result of:
  - 3.1 the information specified in this order
  - 3.2 preparing any pesticide for use and/or using any pesticides
4. A person shall not, before releasing, discharging or applying any pesticide from an aircraft, fail to read, or have read to him, the information specified in this order.

This order is in force from, 16<sup>th</sup> February, 1987 until revoked.
